Our parish needs to replace the portable griddle in the church kitchen. Our current griddle is very cumbersome to use, is not in good repair and is deemed unsafe to use. We have found a new unit that would be a great replacement. This unit would be quite versatile and could be used for many events that could cook a wide variety of foods for Tuesday's Table, PCCW, Knights of Columbus and our school fundraisers. It would be setup where the deep fryers are next to the stove. It would be removed for the fish fry season but returned to the location when the fish fry is complete. The PCCW, Tuesday's Table, and the Knights of Columbus are all planning to contribute towards the purchase of this unit. The numbers show that we are short of the total amount needed. We have commitments for \$4000 so far. The new griddle comes to \$5000.00 plus shipping and installation kit. 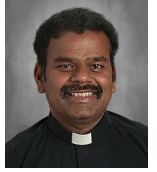
